Thank you to all that have made the transition to DACdb View and Edit! If you have not done that yet, the month of June is the best time to make that change so that you are ready for the new Rotary year starting July 1. It is very easy to do: An officer in your club should Log into My Rotary and go to your club page. At the bottom of your club page is the vendor management section. You will need to Terminate Club Runner, Terminate DACdb as View only and then Add DACdb back in as View and Edit. Your information will then transfer back and forth between Rotary International and DACdb.
