Day 1: Sunday, June 15, 2025 • Vancouver



Day 2: Monday, June 16, 2025 • Vancouver

We wake up to breakfast at the hotel and a guided tour of Vancouver. We venture into the 1000+ acres of Stanley Park to see the first-nations totem poles, the seawall promenade, lumberman's arch and more. Keep an eye out for whales in the harbor, blue heron, beavers, and even the five breeding pairs of bald eagles that call this diverse landscape home. We head back into town to visit the Chinatown and Gastown neighborhoods. We have the afternoon and evening on our own to explore other areas of the city, perhaps enjoying a whale watching cruise or a visit to Olympic Village. **B**

Day 3: Tuesday, June 17, 2025 • Rocky Mountaineer/Kamloops

We transfer to the station where we board the iconic Rocky Mountaineer train to begin our "First Passage to the West" journey. The hospitality onboard shines as we are served a hot breakfast on-board, while stunning views of the Frasier Valley pass outside our windows. The landscape changes as we climb the towering peaks of the Coast Mountains. There's time for friendly card and board games with fellow passengers or a quiet moment with a good book before we enjoy a three course meal. Before we





know it, we are disembarking in the charming town of Kamloops. We have the evening at leisure to enjoy dinner on our own. Perhaps we'll stretch our legs with a refreshing walk along the river. **B, L**

Day 4: Wednesday, June 18, 2025 • Rocky Mountaineer/Banff

Continuing in our easterly direction we see ever changing scenery as we climb the mountains. We have exceptional breakfast and lunch service onboard the train. 
Day 5: Thursday, June 19, 2025 • Banff

Check the Rotary International Conference for meetings and activities.


Day 10: Tuesday, June 24, 2025 • Calgary

All cancellations must be in writing. The date of postmark will determine the amount of refund due. Refunds are based on the number of days prior to departure date.

In addition to the above fees, any hotel penalties may be assessed. All air tickets are non-refundable once purchased.
