

## **2022 Service Project Competition**

For this year's All-Ohio PETS, the five District Governors-Elect in Ohio have challenged each other to a fun and impactful service project competition.

With a goal to donate **16,000** blankets to warm the hearts of children in the foster care system throughout Ohio, as part of this year's All-Ohio PETS, we are holding a competition to see which district can donate the most blankets per capita, based on membership of each district as of July 1, 2021.

We're partnering with **My Very Own Blanket** for this competition. My Very Own Blanket is an Ohio nonprofit corporation founded by Jessica Rudolph in 2000. *Jessica is also the current president of the Rotary Club of Columbus Short North!* 

How can you and your club get involved? Go to <u>https://www.myveryownblanket.org/rotary-all-ohio-pets.html</u> and simply follow the steps on the website. There, you will have the option to:

- Donate a quilt or knitted/crocheted blanket. Work alone or with your quilt guild or knitting group to
  make your own blanket. <u>Purchase a Blanket Tag</u> for 36 cents per tag to be sown on your blanket. Sign
  the Blanket Tag with your club's name and bring the blankets with you to AOP.
- Purchase a no-sew fleece blanket kit Pay \$10 per blanket to get all you need to make a blanket for your club project. When ordering, be sure to select your district and put your club name in the Comments box. Sign the Blanket Tag with your club's name and bring the blankets with you to AOP.
- <u>Sponsor a blanket</u> Donate \$10 per blanket you want to donate, and My Very Own Blanket will
  partner with senior care communities and workshops for people with developmental disabilities to make
  a sponsored blanket. When ordering select your district and put your club name in the Comments box.

The winning district will be awarded the "AOP Service Project Champions Cup."
