



RYLA Selection Criteria

Leadership Potential: Does the applicant possess the qualities required of an

effective leader?

Leadership Experience: Does he/she have experience in a leadership (e.g. class

officer, team captain, school club officer)

Academic Ability:Do they seriously pursues his/her studies to the best of their

ability?

Extracurricular Activities:Does the individual participate in after-school activities?

Relationship with Peers: How easily does the individual get along with others?

Openness to RYLA Experience: Are they willing and eager to participate in a new experience,

with a new group of peers?

Diversity:Does the candidate reflect the cultural diversity of your

community?

Commitment: Will the applicant dedicate themselves to fully participate for

the entire workshop?
