- Tasting will be open from 5 PM - 7 PM.
- 1st, 2nd, 3rd Prizes will be awarded around 7 PM.

We will provide:

- tables, table coverings, and chairs for volunteers who will serve your chili.
- serving pans, serving utensils, and sterno for each registered chili.
- a container for your votes/tickets.
- You will not need to stay with your chili, but will want to return to the Chili Cook-Off area just prior to 7 PM for the announcement of the winners.
- a table with a list of participants in no particular order. You may bring cards for your organization/business to put next to your name.

We ask that you please:

- arrive at 3:00 PM.
- provide 3 gallons of chili.
- please keep your chili anonymous.
- provide a list of ingredients in your chili for patrons to check for allergies
- provide a classification of how hot it is - mild, medium, hot, alarm, ghost.
- bring chili already hot - it will be transferred to serving pans heated by sterno.
