DISTRICT 6910 SERVICE PROJECTS

DEADLINE: April 15, 2024

District 6910 will present a “best” monetary award for each of the four described projects (community, vocational, international or youth).

Best Service Projects: Successful service projects use funds and club members’ time to help those in need. Determine and submit your BEST Service Projects. Recognition will be given for the following Best Service Opportunities: (a) Community Service (b) Vocational Service (c) International of Service and (d) Youth Service. The source of data will be documented service projects on Rotary Club Central and project submission. However, only one submission per service project type.

The project categories will be judged as follows:

- Small and Medium Clubs – A \$250 grant will be awarded in the (4) four project categories.
- Large and X-Large Clubs – A \$500 grant will be awarded in the (4) four project categories.

A total of (8) eight awards will be awarded across the district.

Note: The club can choose to submit their overall best service projects in Community Service, Vocational Service, International Service, or Youth Service or pick and choose. However, only one submission per service project.
