There are two different types of scholarships being offered this year. To be considered for one of the Jupiter/Tequesta Rotary scholarships, please note in the heading of the essay which is the scholarship option of choice, either "Academic Scholarship" or "Vocational Scholarship". Essay is limited to a 500 word max.

Academic Scholarship 1 Year — Total Available \$30,000 This is a traditional academic scholarship. Please note scholarship choice in the heading of the essay

Vocational Scholarship 1 Year — Total Available \$7,500 Rotary-Boyhan Family American Heritage Scholarship

This scholarship is limited to those students planning to attend a State College or other training facility to pursue a career in the trades. Please note scholarship choice in the heading of the essay

- Weighted GPA
- High School transcript, class rank, SAT/ACT scores
- Completed Volunteer, Activities, Honors and Awards section of application
- No more than two letters of recommendation, i.e. teachers, guidance counselors, employers, ministers, etc.
