- ⇒ Backpack with food all participants will wear backpacks with food they're donating to the Village of Wellington's Annual Food Drive. Entrants can chose from several weight classes.
- ⇒ **2k and 5k courses** we're offering a choice of two distances along a scenic paved route at Wellington's premier sports park.
- ⇒ Run or walk—everyone will be timed, but they can choose either a high impact or casual experience. Runners will enjoy the extra challenge of the weight.
- ⇒ Individual or team—you can be solo or part of a 4 person ruck team
- ⇒ Open to all ages men, women and children are invited. Registrants will choose from age groups.
- ⇒ **Trophies and medallions**—30 trophied categories based on different categories with medallions distributed to all participants.
- ⇒ **US Marine Corps Birthday Celebration** established November 10, 1775 in Philadelphia to augment Revolutionary War naval forces.
- ⇒ Avenue of Flags—a display of flags near the finishing line honoring our country and those who serve it.
- ⇒ **Everyone is invited** You don't have to register to come and watch and donate food.
