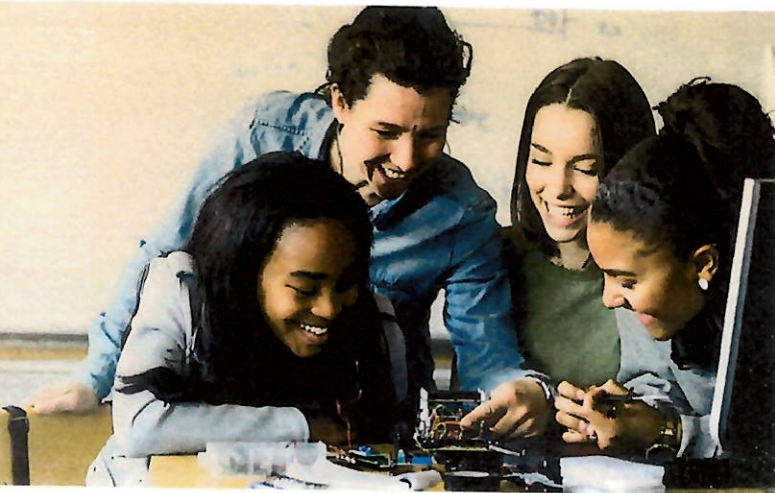

Two of every three new jobs created in Florida by 2025 will require education or training beyond high school.

Today's students need higher education to adapt and thrive in our changing economic landscape.

Fast-track technical or vocational certificate programs can launch students into many high-demand careers. For other eligible students, we have an opportunity to get them on a two- or four-year post-secondary path with a remarkable, highly flexible scholarship opportunity that covers a full year of Florida college tuition.
