While they were at the convention, a company called **My Taxi** donated 100% of the proceeds from Rotarians going to and from the Convention. This amounted to 70,000 Euros.

All of the presentations at the Convention were in English, and the Convention was presided over for the first time by a German as Rotary International President.

We were told of the **Global Polio Initiative**, which has eradicated 99.9% of the Polio disease throughout the world. We were also introduced to the **Bee Pasture Project**, which helps wild bees, who do not have hives, and are disappearing. The initiative also helps wild butterflies.

We were also shown a video of Mike and Janet's reunion with Rotary Exchange Student, **Marie Hacker**, and her Mother. Marie stayed with Mike and Janet during the time that she was in our area.

Finally, we were shown video of the elaborate miniature train station and Frankfort Airport, complete with moving trains and planes. There was even a miniature of Key West.
