



## 2024- 2025 District Governor Awards

Rotary celebrates people of action who are committed to service and whose lives mirror Rotary's values. Our District Leadership Team hopes all clubs will work to achieve the goals established for the Rotary Citation and Presidential Distinction, Rotary Service Awards, and the District Governor Awards. Monitoring of these achievements will be tracked by the information you input into My Rotary.

The District Governor Awards for 2024-25 align with the Rotary Vision Statement, building upon the concepts of building IRRESISTIBLE Rotary Clubs, and making magic through Rotary.

Rotary Vision Statement:

*Together, we see a world where people unite and take action to create lasting change – across the globe, in our communities, and in ourselves.*

We encourage all clubs to qualify for the Rotary Presidential Citation, as well as achieve a top District Governor Award.

In order for your club to qualify for the District Governor Awards, a final submission of the following District Awards Criteria should be submitted to your Area Governor by May 1, 2025.

\*Please note that Membership and Foundation giving awards will be based on Rotary year-end results on July 1, 2025. Those awards will be distributed at the District Workshop in the fall 2025.

This year's District Governor Awards will be based upon a point system and we continue to trust you will use the *4-Way Test* when submitting your responses.

Award Levels: All criteria are evenly weighted. Indicated number of completed criteria determines the award level.

- Bronze 21 - 25
- Silver 26 - 30
- Gold 31 - 35
- Platinum 36 - 40
