Prizes

The contest winner will receive \$2,000; the 1st runner-up will receive \$1,000; other contestants will receive \$500.

Purpose

The purpose of the 4-Way Test is to promote ethical principles in both everyday life and business. The contest is specifically designed to introduce high school students to Rotary and the 4-Way Test by generating interest through a competitive event sponsored by their local Rotary club.

Goals

- Familiarize a large number of youth with Rotary and the 4-Way Test.
- Demonstrate and enhance Rotarians' commitment to youth.
- Heighten awareness of Rotary among parents, school officials, and the community at large.
- Recognize, encourage, and reward hard work and accomplishments in our youth.
- Provide an opportunity for Rotarians to participate in a Community/Vocational Service program that focuses on the 4-Way Test as our standard of behavior.

Entry Information

There are three levels of competition: Club, Regional, and District.

- 1. Clubs who would like to compete must submit the Club Entry Form by January 31, 2025, Club-level contests are required to be conducted before February 28, 2025.
- 2. Regional contests will be held in early March 2025; specific dates and locations to come Locations will be determined based on the clubs entering the contest.
- 3. District contest will be held at the Spring Conference on March 29th in Bedford, PA.

- February 28, 2025 Club contests must be concluded.
- March 1, 2025 Submit the club winner's information.
- March 8th & 15th 2025 Regional contests; locations and dates to be decided.
- March 29, 2025 District contest, Bedford, PA.
