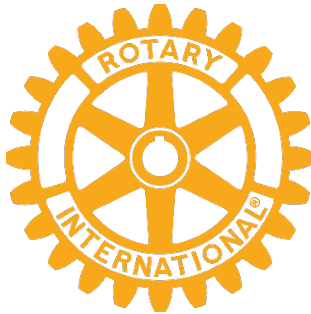

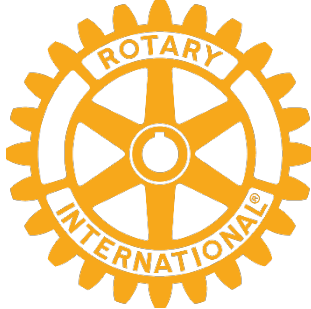
Application Procedures:

Transcripts are not necessary. Successful applicants will be invited to ride in the Langhorne Memorial Day Parade and to receive their monetary award at a Rotary Club luncheon in the summer.

In 1965 he established (BCI) Bucks County International, Inc. truck dealership in Langhorne. In 2006 he added BCI Idealease, Inc., which leases and rents trucks. Finally, in 2008 in Trenton, NJ, he added BCI Truck, Inc., which does truck repairs and parts sales. Over his years in business, Gene has given many technical students the opportunity to work at his companies, and years later some are still working for the business.

Eugene W. Hieber Scholarship Fund will be awarded to worthy high school senior attending Bucks County Technical High School. One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to an applicant pursuing further education at trade school or college in a technical field and excelling in "service above self".
