INITIATIVES

CREATE GREATER IMPACT

- Administer a community assessment survey and take at least one action based on the results
- Complete at least one service project with a non-Rotary partner organization
- At least one non-club member participates in a service project
- Increase the club's financial support to the Rotary Foundation Annual Fund over the 2022-2023 end-of-Rotary year total
- Increase the club's financial support to Polio Plus over the 2022-2023 end-of-Rotary year total

INCREASE OUR REACH

- Publish a monthly informational publication for club and community members
 - ° Newsletter, website articles, social media, podcast
- Submit at least one article for the district newsletter
- Have at least one quarterly "Get to Know Rotary Event"
- Create a Satellite Club, Impact Club, Companion Club, or Community Rotaract Club

ENHANCE ENGAGEMENT

- Sponsor at least one Youth Services related activity
 - ° Interact Club, Youth Exchange, RYLA, Mentoring
- Integrate Club activities and events into DACdb Calendar
- Use the DACdb Engagement Module to track all club service activities and all weekly meeting attendance

ADAPT TO MAKE OUR CLUB IRRESISTIBLE

- All Club Officers complete job-specific training on Rotary Club Central
 - ° President, Treasurer, Secretary, Public Image, Membership, Foundation Chair
- Develop and implement a Club Leadership Continuity Plan
- Adopt an alternative membership model
 - Corporate, Family Member, Service Only, Passport, etc.
