

# Rotary Club of McLean Board Meeting Agenda – July 9th, 2024

**CALL TO ORDER: 11:04 AM** 

APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM JUNE 11th MEETING: Carol King moved we approved; Vance Zavela seconded. The entire board was in favor; no one opposed; motion passed.

## TREASURER'S REPORT: 11:04 AM; Michael Arietti

Michael Arietti shared that we ended the Rotary year on June 30 with a Bank balance of over \$22 thousand dollars which is around the same amount we have had in the past. Which is good. He reminded us about the discussion about the budget for this current year and that we didn't break even on catering costs. So, we have raised the meal dues so hopefully we wouldn't have that problem in this current year. Vance Zavela shared that he has approximately \$471.52 to hand over from McLean Day and July 4<sup>th</sup> water sales. Michael shared that he is waiting for the Rotary International and district six month invoices to know how much to charge our members per capita for those two expenses. So, Michael is waiting for those before he can produce invoices for this year's first quarter. Michael Arietti – suggested we reduce the induction fee from \$50 to \$25. Vance Zavela – suggested we include a Rotary shirt instead of reducing the induction fee. Carol King shared that ordering 1 shirt at a time makes it too expensive. To avoid that expense she could order some shirts in advance (i.e. six of each) Michael Arietti rescinded his suggestion of lowering the induction fee. All agreed to keep the \$50 fee. Michael Arietti shared that the \$25 per quarter fee was not sent into Rotary International back in June. The only downside of that is the club will not get credit for that amount of money. The check will be sent but in the end it may affect any potential recognition we have. Cecilia Closs shared she would be willing to call Rotary International to argue why we should get credit. Vance Zavela shared that some of us are going to Evanston next month and we could bring this topic up.

**Carol King** shared that she just has a couple details to confirm but other than that the new calendar ready to be printed. There will not be meetings on October 1, November 5 & 26, December 24 & 31.
