- Rotary is a worldwide organization of business and professional leaders that provides humanitarian service, encourages high ethical standards in all vocations, and helps build goodwill and peace in the world.
- Approximately 1.2 million Rotarians are members of more than 35,000 Rotary clubs located in over 200 countries and territories.
- The first Rotary Club was founded in 1905. The name "Rotary" derived from the early practice of rotating meetings among members' offices.
- Rotary is now the largest and most influential civic club in the world.
- The Rotary Motto is: "Service Above Self".

<u>The Object of Rotary</u> is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:

- The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service
- High ethical standards in business and professions, the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations, and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society

Getting Started As A New Member

Mecklenburg County-South Rotary utilizes a New Member Recognition program to help new members get to know other club members and Rotary's full scope of offerings. Our New Member Recognition program is in place to help enhance your experience with our club.

New members are welcomed into the club during one of our regularly scheduled meetings. During this meeting, new members are presented with a membership certificate and other rotary keepsakes. We encourage new members to invite their families and others to attend their membership induction to join in the celebration. New members will be assigned a mentor to assist in the acclimation to our club and Rotary overall.

We also ask our new members to engage in the following activities, designed to enhance their experience and overall enjoyment with our club (these activities are typically completed in an approximate six-month timeframe).

All new members must:

- 1. Maintain at least 50% attendance in person or online
- 2. Pay dues on time
- 3. Work closely with your mentor and/or sponsor to get the most enjoyment and level of engagement with your new club and Rotary overall

We also ask our new members to complete any four (4) of the following:

- 1. Get involved with one of our committees
- 2. Invite a guest to one of our meetings
- 3. Attend one of our board meetings
- 4. Attend a club social event
- 5. Participate in a community service project
- 6. Lead the club in a non-denominational invocation, the pledge of allegiance, and health & happiness at one meeting
- 7. Assist the Sergeant-at-Arms at one meeting
- 8. Provide an informal presentation about yourself during a regular meeting



Membership Application Process

- 1. Visit the club a few times, and get to know some of our members and the structure of our meetings.
- 2. Review the information in this packet and spend a little time at the Rotary International website at <u>www.rotary.org</u> and the Meck-South website at <u>www.mecksouthrotary.org</u>.
- 3. Fill out the enclosed membership application or go online to http://lsMyRotaryClub.org/NewMember/?ClubID=50414 and fill in our electronic application.
- 4. Have a meeting with the Club's Membership Director Greg Snoor to discuss your commitment to Rotary and what Rotary can do for you.
- 5. Your membership application is announced to the club at two consecutive weekly meetings.
- 6. Board members have a formal vote to induct all new members.
- 7. Membership is granted and announced in a formal presentation at our meeting (family and/or spouses are invited and encouraged to attend this meeting). A new member kit will be presented to you at this meeting.
- 8. Pay your first quarterly dues along with the initiation fee.
- 9. Get involved and have fun!
