




Four Seasons Hotels and Rotary Club Experience



Last month, hoteliers from six continents gathered for the unveiling of the World's 50 Best Hotel List. It was no surprise that one of the top hotel brands in the world, Four Seasons, garnered 4 spots on the list. Four Seasons' success is attributed to its commitment around three c's. They are:

- 1) Craftmanship The dedication and passion that each employee has for their profession.
- Connection A core tenet is to provide highly personalized service. Staff members are trained to anticipate guests' needs and tailor their experiences to ensure every interaction feels special and unique.
- 3) <u>Character -</u> Employees are "culture-carriers" with a focus on doing the job the right way. They operate by the Golden Rule. Acting with deep empathy and always treating others as they wish to be treated.

I mention this because creating a Rotary Club experience where members and guests feel comfortable, cared for, and valued is the surest way to attract and keep members. This experience is important because **we lose 10% percent of new members in the first year and up to 50% by year three**. Three keys to creating an exceptional experience are:





- 2) <u>Dynamic Meaningful Service</u> There are countless stories across the district where clubs tackle big problems in their local community and help to solve them, which leads to significant membership growth!
- 3) <u>Connections</u> It's essential that members feel cared for, valued and heard. Comfort and care committees, fellowship events, and satisfaction surveys are a few examples to build greater connections.


