


# FLORENCE ROTARY BEAUTY TRAIL

Created in the 1940s by Rotarians Charlie Womack and Dolph Mobley, the Florence Rotary Beauty Trail highlights 13 miles of this beautiful residential area.

# DRIVING TOUR DIRECTIONS

Start at the intersection of South Edisto and Hillside Drives (1300 Hillside Dr will work for GPS location) at sign #1.

Drive west on Hillside Dr 0.3 mi, then turn left on Dorchester Rd, at sign #2.

Drive 0.25 mi, and turn right on Cherry Blossom Ln at sign #3.

Drive NW on Cherry Blossom Ln, and turn right on Deberry Blvd at sign #4. Deberry Blvd becomes Wisteria Dr.

As you travel 0.25 mi NE on Deberry Blvd, you will pass sign #5 and the Florence Country Club on your left and Jeffries Creek Park on your right. Continue another 0.4 mi.

The road turns right to become Wisteria Dr (pause at South Edisto Dr near sign #6 for audio to catch up). Continue east for 1.3 mi until Wisteria Dr turns left to become Santee Dr. Here you will begin meandering along shady boulevards. (Pause for audio.)

Drive 500 ft on Santee Dr, and turn left on Oleander Dr at sign #8. Continue west 0.2 mi on Oleander Dr, and turn right on Park Ave at sign #9.

Drive north 430 ft on Park Dr, and turn right on Iris Dr at sign #10. Follow Iris Dr 0.2 mi to Santee Dr where you will turn left at sign #11.

Drive north on Santee Dr 270 ft, and turn left on Juanita Dr at sign #12. Travel west 0.25 mi on Juanita Dr to turn right on Park Ave at sign #13.

Travel north 300 ft on Park Ave, and turn right on Azalea Ln at sign #14. You will pass Lucas Park on your left. Travel east 0.25 mi on Azalea Ln, and turn left on Santee Dr at sign #15.

Drive north 0.15 mi on Santee Dr, pass Seminole Ave, and turn left on Camellia Circle at Sign #16. You will pass sign #17 on your right.

Follow Camellia Circle 0.4 mi to Park Ave, and turn right at sign #18.

Follow Park Ave north 0.4 mi (pause for audio to catch up before crossing Cherokee Rd), cross Cherokee Rd at sign #19/25 on your left. Turn right on Spruce St at sign #20. (Pause for audio.)

Drive east 0.2 mi on Spruce St, and turn right on Timrod Park Dr at sign #21.

Follow Timrod Park Dr 0.4 mi, passing sign #22 on your left. (Pause near tennis courts.)

Turn right on S Coit St at sign #23.

Note: there is an option to follow the 2005 trail extension (not mentioned in the audio tour) through the downtown area — see highlighted directions. This portion was added in celebration of the 100th Anniversary of Rotary International.

If you choose to follow the main route, turn right on Cherokee Rd at sign #24.

## 2005 TRAIL EXTENSION

(Stop audio for this portion.)

Turn left on Cherokee Rd, and drive east 0.2 mi to S Dargan St traffic light at sign #24A. To the right before turning is Mount Hope Cemetery.

Follow S Dargan St 0.7 mi, passing the Florence County Library, Florence Little Theater, and FMU PAC on the left.

Turn left on W Cheves St at sign 24B. Florence County Museum is on the immediate right after turning.

Follow W Cheves St 0.2 mi (2 blocks) to sign #24C, and turn left on S Coit St. Follow S Coit St 0.8 mi to continue the main route by taking a right on Cherokee Rd at sign #24.

(Resume audio.)

Drive west 2.0 mi on Cherokee Rd, (at the 0.6 mi mark, you may pause at Calvary Baptist Church), passing signs #25, #26, and #27 on your right.

Just before Five Points, at sign #28, turn sharply left onto Country Club Blvd.

Take Country Club Blvd southeast 0.3 mi, pass sign #29, and follow sign #30 to continue on Country Club Rd.

Turn right on Fairway Dr at sign #31, and proceed 0.3 mi.

Turn right on Rosewood Dr at sign #32, drive 0.4 mi (pausing near Highland Ave), and make a soft right on Pineland Ave at sign #33.

Drive 0.1 mi, carefully crossing Cherokee Rd at sign #34.

At sign #35, keep on Pineland Ave to the right.

At sign #36, turn left on Greenway Dr.

Take an immediate right on Madison Ave at sign #37, and pass sign #38. (Pause near S Edisto Dr near sign #39.) At sign #40, turn left at Madison Ave northeast then immediately east (right) at sign #41. To cross South Franklin Dr at sign #42, turn right, and immediately turn sharply to the left. Turn right again to continue on Madison Ave.

Turn right on Lafayette Circle at sign #43. Drive 400 ft, and turn right on Jackson Ave at sign #44.

At sign #45, turn sharply left on S Franklin Dr. (pausing in this area). Turn right on Jackson Ave at sign #46. You will pass sign #47 on your right.

(Pause before turning.) Turn left on S Edisto Dr at sign #48. Drive south over Cherokee Rd, passing signs #49, #50 and #51. Arrive at starting point sign #1.
