

Kara and Jonathan's Biography

Kara Story recently graduated from the University of Arkansas-Fayetteville with a Master's in Choral Conducting. While at the U of A she served as conductor of Donna Voce, musical director of the Barbara Mashburn Singers, and worship leader of Calvary Chapel in Rogers. In May of 2010 she completed her Bachelor of Arts in Music at the University of Arkansas-Fort Smith, where she participated in the Jazz Catz, the Jazz Band, the UAFS Chorale and the Vocal Performance Workshop. She was named Outstanding Soloist at the North Texas Jazz Festival in April 2008. She currently resides in Fayetteville, teaches voice and piano privately, and participates in the choir and praise team at Central United Methodist Church.

Jonathan Story received his Master's in Piano Performance in 2008 from the University of Arkansas. Dubbed "Fayetteville's Piano Man", he serves as organist of Central United Methodist Church in Fayetteville, pianist for the Singing Men of Arkansas, and President of the Barbara Mashburn Scholarship Foundation. His virtuosity on piano and organ have taken him to venues including Germany, Austria, Ireland and even the White House in Washington, DC. He is a sales associate at Coldwell Banker Harris McHaney & Faucette in Fayetteville, and is active in his church, having recently traveled to Peru and Uganda on medical missions.
