Few of us found it easy to figure out what some of the devices were, but sort we did and created a mound of boxes which were then weighed and recorded, and placed on the warehouse shelves for eventual packing into square pallets that will load into a shipping crate. Supplies have gone to Haiti after their devastation--even to Joplin! No new member should miss the opportunity to learn more as they work the warehouse duty.


