I am so glad I joined Rotary and to be part of a wonderful organization with great people.

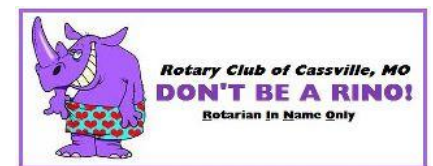
