## **Drumright Public School Foundation speaks to Rotary**

The Drumright Public School Foundation has raised over \$55,000 since 2004 and one one-hundred percent of that money has gone back into Drumright's school system. The process is simple for teachers. A teacher that wishes to obtain a certain tool or piece of equipment writes a grant request for that need. The request is submitted to the board for consideration. The Foundation works diligently to fulfill as many grant requests as funds allow.

In order to accomplish that, fundraisers are necessary. The main fundraiser each year is the Drumright Public School Foundation Memorial Golf Tournament. Each year the Foundation organizes a Golf Tournament, which is held on the Saturday of Memorial Weekend. Local businesses participate by donating door prizes and food.

There are many ways to participate in the golf tournament. If you enjoy playing golf, participate on a four-man team. However, if being a spectator is more your sport, then sponsor a hole. Last year the tournament raised over \$11,000 for the foundation.

The golf tournament is a family event. The Foundation has made every effort to ensure that participants have a fun and enjoyable day. The Drumright Public School Foundation Golf Tournament will begin at 9 a.m. on Saturday, May 26<sup>th</sup> at the Drumright Golf Course.
