This March, as we celebrate Rotary's Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) Month, we have an incredible opportunity to create lasting change in our communities and beyond. The stark reality is that 748 million people worldwide still lack access to clean drinking water, and nearly 1,400 children die each day from diseases caused by poor sanitation and unsafe water.

The Magic of Rotary comes alive when we tackle these challenges head-on. As shared by our Rotary International President Stephanie A. Urchick, even simple solutions can seem magical to those in need - like when children in the Dominican Republic watched in amazement as dirty water became clean through a basic filter

Our impact as Rotarians extends far beyond just building wells. We create comprehensive solutions that include:

- Installing rainwater harvesting systems
- Building sanitation facilities, and helping maintain them
- Teaching communities about proper hygiene


Local Programs Have Global Impacts
