Health Care Equity in Washington

Overview: Many of us have struggled to get access to the health care we need, and the national shortage of providers continues to increase. At the Elson S. Floyd College of Medicine, we are working to educate more providers to address the national shortage, starting in WA. Through collaboration and problem-solving in education, research, and health care, with a focus on rural communities, Tribal Nations and people who have been historically marginalized, we are working toward a healthy, equitable Washington for all. I will share more about



how we are doing this, and how Rotary Clubs across WA have been partners in this critical mission.

Bio: I'm the Senior Director of Development at the WSU Elson S. Floyd College of Medicine. I partner with alumni, foundations, organizations, and community members to raise awareness and resources to advance the mission and vision of our college. I joined the college in 2023 after spending the prior eight years fundraising with a local hospital, and previously in communications. I hail from a rural community in Wisconsin and have been in Seattle for more than a decade.

Notes from Service Fund Board Meeting March 6, 2025 (by Paula Laschober)

Three International Service Committee projects were approved for funding:

- Kenya, drill a borehole well Star of Hope Children's Centre (\$31,490 project, \$3,050 from UDRC)
- Ethiopia, peace thru arts, contribution to Ballard RC GG (\$36,000 project, \$1,000 from UDRC)
- Gambia, support for village medical center, contribution to Lake Forest Park RC District matching grant (\$20,200 project, \$2,000 from UDRC)

2 Ways To Donate Clothes and Household Goods (by Rick Jones)

Over the past year our club has been working closely with two entities that re-purpose and distribute lightly-used clothes and household goods. It's easy to access and here's how to do it:

Solid Ground works to help folks settle into a permanent home, often for

the first time. Their clients are coming from short-term housing, incarceration, or a refugee situation. These folks need all the items it takes to establish a home, often for a family.

Used but working small appliances (coffeemakers, toasters, toaster ovens, hand mixers, blenders, etc.) along with dishes, glasses, cutlery, bakeware, pans, etc. are all needed. Additionally, clothes that are workplace suitable are needed for both men and women.

The **University District Family YMCA** works in our neighborhood and is directly helping people, often in deep poverty and often living on the street or in cars. They have an appetite for warm clothes and rain resistant clothes for both men and women. Especially sought after are belts and shoes/boots.

His other community activities include serving on the Board for the new Memorial Stadium, and as a Community Court Advocate. He has also assisted in opening a school in Nigeria.


Robert's interests include youth and young adult achievement, education, fundraising and ministry. His hobbies are traveling and spending time with grandchildren.
