We are calling for help with mulching and general care in the forest on the following dates:

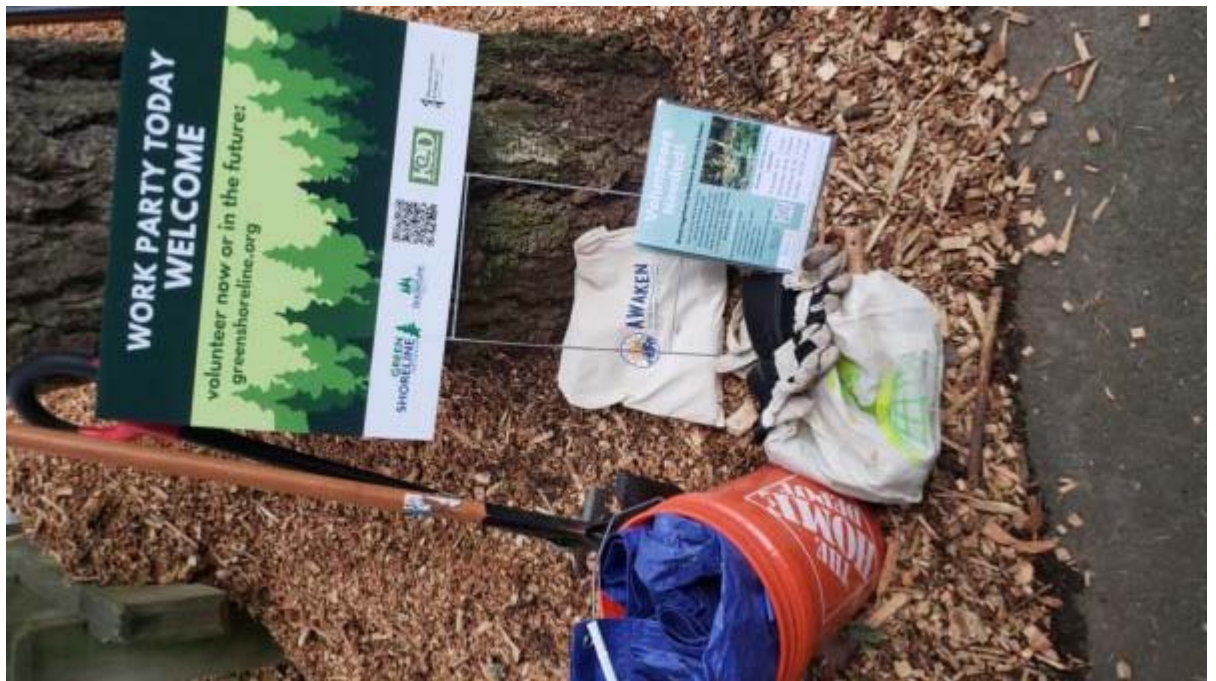
