How to Sign In to DACdb and Rotary International

To access important Rotary resources, follow these steps to sign in to DACdb and Rotary International.

YOU HAVE TO BE ABLE TO LOG IN TO YOUR EMAIL ACCOUNT

Step 1: Signing into DACdb

1. Go to DACdb Login.
2. Enter the email address you used when you became a Rotary member.
 - If you're unsure which email was used, let me know, and I can look it up for you.
3. Click "Forgot Password" and follow the prompts to reset your password.
4. Check your email for the reset link and complete the process.
5. Once logged in, save your login information somewhere accessible in case you forget
6. it, especially if you switch between work and personal computers.

Step 2: Signing into Rotary International

1. Go to Rotary International Login.
2. Click Register, which is located on the upper right-hand side.
3. Follow the instructions
4. Pro Tip: Use the same email address and password as you used for DACdb.
5. Save your login information for future access.

Helpful Tips:

- For convenience, use the same password for both accounts so it's easy to remember.
- If you need help resetting your password or accessing your account, feel free to reach

out!

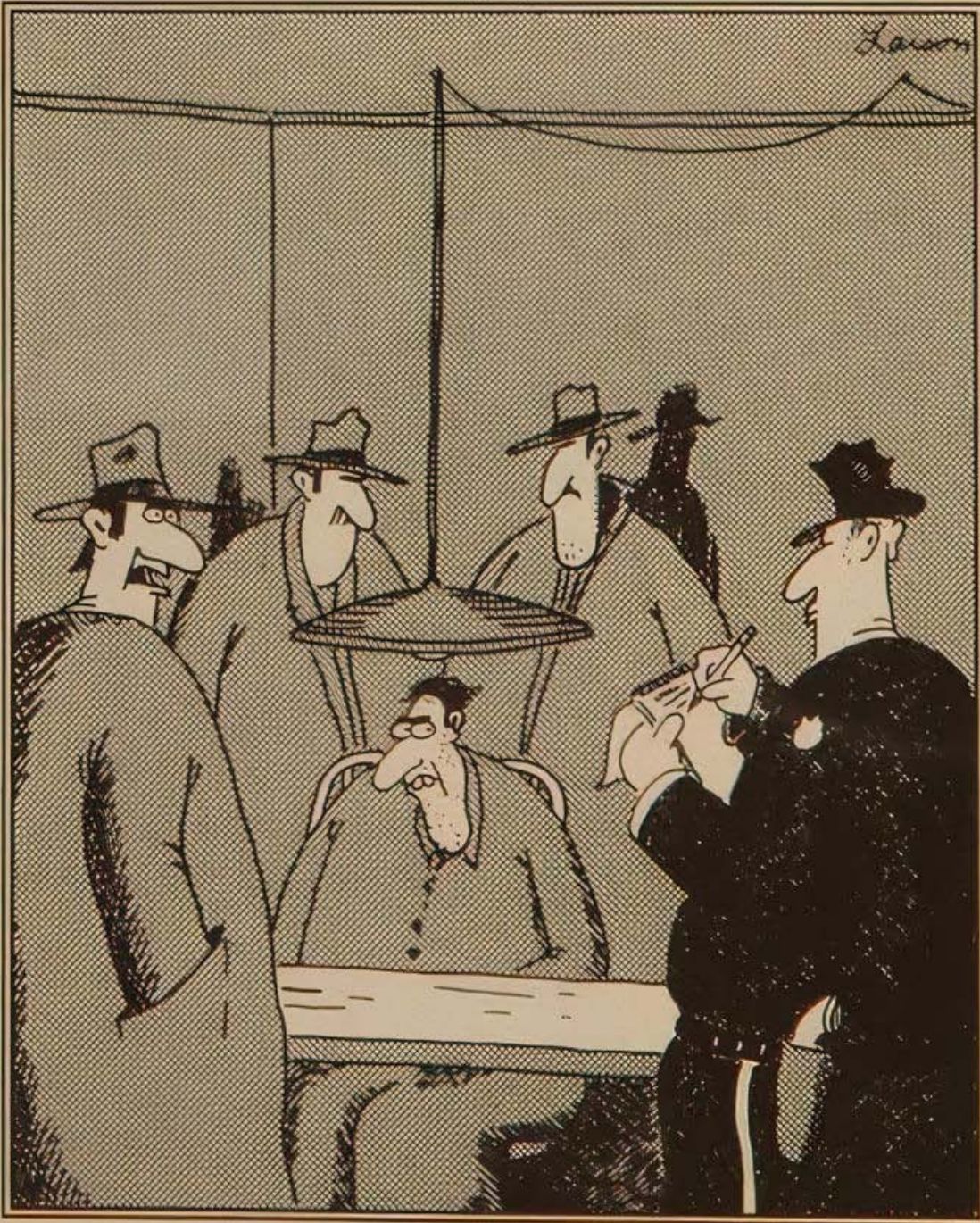

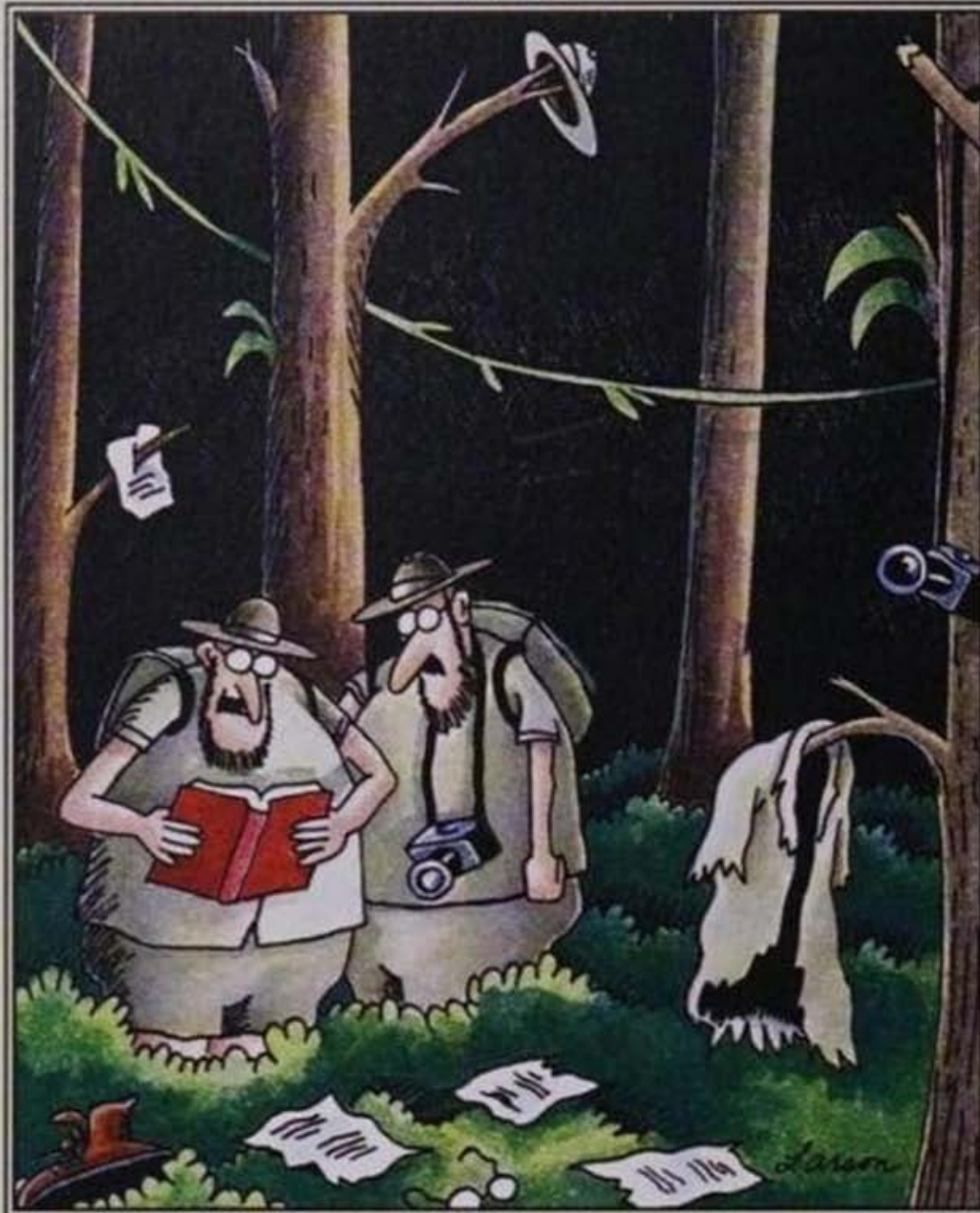
