Update:

December is the perfect time to review your charitable donations for the 2024 tax year. Metro's goal for total member contributions to The Rotary Foundation in the 2024-25 Rotary year is \$12,000. Contributions made between July 1, 2024 and June 30, 2025 will count towards that goal. Since July 1, 14 members have contributed \$3,920 to TRF. TRF is the bank that makes our district and global grants possible. Every penny you give will return to our district after three years in the form of matching funds for grants. If you haven't already done so, please set up an automatic monthly contribution to The Rotary Foundation via your credit card.
