



The Rotary Foundation - Club Activity



The mission of The Rotary Foundation of Rotary International ("TRF") is to enable Rotarians to advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace through the improvement of health, the support of education, and the alleviation of poverty. Its primary project is to eradicate polio worldwide. Rotarians may contribute to TRF through one-time gifts or ongoing by direct deposit. Every Rotarian is encouraged to donate an amount Every Year. For each \$1,000 donated over any period of time, a Rotarian is designated a Paul Harris Fellow ("PHF"), with each subsequent PHF identified with +#. Additionally, a Rotarian who donates \$10,000 or more is designated a Major Donor, with 4 levels of Major Donor recognition based on the amount donated. Individuals who commit US\$10,000 or more to the Rotary Foundation Endowment, via estate plans, are recognized as Bequest Society Members. Each month, the Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano distributes enough emergency and supplemental food to provide 2.7 million meals. They strive to serve all people experiencing hunger or food insecurity in Solano and Contra Costa counties through their partnership with Feeding America, a nonprofit network of 200 food banks. The Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano started in 1975 with 15 local food pantries and agencies employing two staff members. Now they operate out of two warehouses in Concord and Fairfield and consistently earn Charity Navigator's highest four-star rating.

As the phrase goes, many hands make light work. What better hands to work next to than fellow Rotarians from the Vacaville Sunrise Club? We've established a quarterly volunteering opportunity which we expect to be the beginning of a long tradition. No experience required, just bring your smile??
