### Brad & Rosemarie Barbeau Egypt: Tombs, Temples, & Tourist Traps

Dr. Brad Barbeau, Ph.D., recently retired as Professor of Entrepreneurship at the CSU Monterey Bay College of Business and Executive Director of the CSUMB Institute for Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development (iiED). As a faculty member, he taught courses in entrepreneurship and new venture formation and finance. As Executive Director for the iiED, he devoted his efforts to building the entrepreneurial ecosystem in the Monterey Bay region and developing and accelerating entrepreneurial ventures. Dr. Barbeau continues to work

with startup companies both in operating capacities and as an outside advisor. He is a board member at El Pajaro Community Development Corporation, Santa Cruz Works, and the Gateway Center of Monterey County where he is Chair of the Board and currently the Interim Executive Director. He is also a consultant with the Small Business Development Center for Monterey & San Benito counties. Dr. Barbeau holds an undergraduate degree in economics and history from Michigan State University, and holds an MBA, an M.A. in economics and Ph.D. in business administration from the University of Michigan's Ross School of Business.



Rosemarie Barbeau is a retired organization development consultant based in the Monterey, California area. Since 1988 she has helped clients develop strategy, implement key initiatives and build the collaborative partnerships required to be successful. She has also provided high impact process facilitation to support large enterprise-wide projects and to develop effective teams.

Her client list included Blue Cross and Blue Shield Association, Kaiser Permanente, the University of Southern California, The University of California Berkeley, Deloitte, Earthjustice, The Getty Trust and the Smithsonian.

She has been published in The Flawless Consulting Field Book and Companion: A Guide to Understanding Your Expertise, Organization Development Classics: The Practice and Theory of Change – the Best of the OD Practitioner and The Handbook of Large Group Methods: Creating Systemic Change in Organizations and Communities.
