## Mayor Sal Melendez visits Rotary Club 3-5-2025

### Montebello Mayor Melendez presents to the Rotary Club



On Wednesday, March 5th, 2025, at **Quiet Cannon**, the **Rotary Club of Montebello** welcomed as its program speaker and presenter the City's own **Mayor, Sal Melendez**.

Mayor **Melendez** provided an overview of the City's recent projects, highlighting some of the more well-known ones; Top Golf, the Tesla facility, the updated Golf Course and Club House Bella Verde, and the Vista de J.J. Rodriguez mixed-use development.

**Top Golf** is averaging about 55,000 visits per month, along with the updated Golf Course and new Club House at Bella Verde. The genesis of which was to help make Montebello a destination location, where local surrounding visitors and residents will come to spend their money and contribute to the City's tax base.

**Tesla** has also begun operations in earnest at the old Costco location, with a possible upcoming groundbreaking ceremony for which discussions are being held; this too should also boost and contribute to the City's tax base.

The **Vista de J.J. Rodriguez** project in downtown will house 63 new residential units, along with ground-level commercial storefronts. An effort and joint project in

collaboration with the Cesar Chavez Foundation to add affordable housing to the downtown development.
