April 29 is the Grand Oping of the Women's & Children's Shelter II. 8 am is breakfast & 10 am is the Ribbon Cutting Ceremony.


May 1 is the National Day of Prayer. A service will be held at CVRM 47470 Van Buren St, Indio from 7-9 am.
