
WE WILL MEET SATURDAY MORNING -- FEBRUARY 8 – AT 9:00 A.M. at the VOLUNTEER TENT to check in with the Volunteer Captain and get your Volunteer Vest. We will be done by 1:00 p.m.

The Volunteer Tent will be on the WEST side of the intersection of ARENAS and PALM CANYON. There will be water, coffee, and snacks available at the Volunteer Tent.

Free Parking is available in the City parking structure at INDIAN CANYON and BARISTO. (Enter on Baristo). There is also a City parking structure on N. Museum Way west of Belardo. Finally, the two-hour parking limitation for street parking downtown is suspended during the Tour. Saturday morning there will be over 5,000 riders, plus family members and friends in downtown Palm Springs starting at 6:30 a.m., so please allow ample time to park and get to the Volunteer Tent by 9:00 a.m.
