In October, Jon Lieberg visited the Brisbane Rotary Club, where he learned about the Kyeema Foundation's work in Papua New Guinea, one of the poorest countries globally. The International Committee donated \$1,000 to support the Kyeema Foundation's Village Chicken Farming program, which enhances food security and income for women by promoting indigenous chicken rearing. The donation also aids their Coral Reef Restoration project, which involves community-led coral gardening to restore degraded reefs, protect biodiversity, and maintain vital fish habitats.

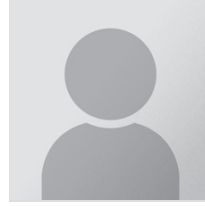
