Program:

PP Tom Mitchell introduced our speaker, Julie Brightwell, Chair of Honor Flight San Diego. Honor Flight San Diego (HFSD) is a non-profit branch of the nationwide Honor Flight Network which consists of over 130 independent "hubs" across America. HFSD escorts veterans to Washington, D.C. to visit their memorials for two flights per year using monies donated by individuals, foundations, associations, business owners and corporations who wish to recognize our veterans' contributions and thank them for their service and sacrifice to the United States and its citizens. Julie showed us a wonderful video made by local Brad Willis, filled with moving testimonials by participating veterans after they saw the memorials and met fellow participants. Julie told us of one WWII POW participant who met by chance on an Honor Flight another WWII veteran who liberated the camp where he was held. They have remained close friends ever since. Over 2,000 veterans have participated in Honor Flights from San Diego. The next San Diego Honor Flight will take place on April 27th at 1 PM; get to the Terminal 2 Baggage Claim by 12 noon.
