Program:

Jeanmarie Bond introduced our speaker, Brendan Farley, a Coronado resident who is the Vice President of Operations for the San Diego Theaters, comprised of the Balboa Theater and the Civic Theater. Brendan let us know that the Balboa Theater celebrated its 100 th anniversary last year and the Civic Theater will celebrate its 60 th this year. He explained that the theaters do not fundraise, but earn income from ticket sales, marketing and operation expense payments from touring shows. Some key metrics he shared for 2024 included: 169 events staged; 290 performances; and attendance of

432,084. They stage a wide variety of productions, from Broadway, ballet and Latin music to opera and classical symphonic productions. Through all of this, their guiding precept is to "create moments that matter" for the audience.


