Ron Bench, MO State Parks, and Rick Mihalevich, President, Friends of Rock Island Trail (FoRIT) presented an update on trail development. To date, MO Rock Island Trail is known for some of the world's largest - largest Rail Trail loops, the largest trailhead at Arrowhead Stadium, the largest cowbell in Belle, the largest horseshoe and hot dog stand in Owensville. The role of State Parks is to be a good neighbor to the landowners along the trail by supporting them in building and maintaining fences along the trail. The goal of State Parks is to build 15 miles of fences/year.



FoRIT is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization that works with trail communities to assist in the development of the Rock Island corridor into a premier Missouri State Park. This organization works to partner with state agencies, trail communities and organizations, advocacy groups, businesses, landowners, and citizens to promote, preserve, and develop the Missouri Rock Island Trail State Park.
