Program: Katherine Rhoades Gonzalez is a former RYLA participant, Youth Exchange Student to France, and an Ambassadorial Scholar-ship recipient with Rotary. In 2021 and following her husband Andres' dream, they both embarked on adventure in their 34-foot Seacraft sail-boat from Seattle to New Zealand with stops including French Polynesia. Katherine read several passages from her book, The Co-Captain's Log, including being in a dense fog, unable to see anything for hours, and they found themselves amid a pod of approximately 200 whales. Another memorable incident was when a severe storm hit and their boat severely listed and fortunately righted itself but her husband was washed overboard and she fractured a kneecap. They were a day out from shore, he was hypothermic, and her knee swollen "as a melon" when they reached port. But both were able to battle to safety and have quite a story to tell. They sailed down the coast to Cabo San Lucas to French Polynesia, Tahiti, ending in New Zealand. During their stops along the way she elaborated on her journal entries and successfully completed the 11,000 nautical mile trip. Katherine shared how they were able to briefly communicate with family, daily routines on the 10-foot-wide sailboat, navigating the vast ocean, and meeting so many wonderful people along the way.
