Sara Deuster, Director of Fort Smith's Parks and Recreation Department, spoke with club members about the city's extensive recreational amenities. Fort Smith maintains 29 parks, including 3 fully inclusive parks, approximately 686 acres, and complemented by 20 miles of paved, multi-use trails.

Under Sara's leadership, several key projects are underway to ensure Fort Smith parks remain a destination point for residents and visitors. Creekmore Park now boasts a new picnic and patio area, a custom train-themed toddler playground, a tunnel for the miniature train, a new basketball court, and sidewalk improvements.

A graduate of UAFS and Carl Albert, Tim began his career in EMS I 1981. Tim worked for twenty-four years at Mercy Hospital as an ER paramedic and a Critical Care Educator. He assumed the role of Executive Director of Fort Smith EMS in late 2008.

Under his leadership Fort Smith EMS completed a total system wide upgrade of equipment and technology to include the most upto-date medical equipment and treatments, a state-of-the-art 911 center, and a new 18,000 square-foot facility covering two acres on Duke Avenue.

Tim is also a graduate of Leadership Fort Smith 2011 and was named the 2012 EMS Executive of the Year by the National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians.
