Mercy Hospital offers a Lung Nodule Program that is referral-based, targeting patients with certain lung cancer screening results. The overall goal is to streamline the evaluation and management of individuals with identified lung nodules, offering a faster and more efficient approach to patient care. This streamlined approach reduces the chances of oversight and ensures that at-risk patients don't fall through the cracks. To expedite the care of patients in the lung nodule program, they collaborate closely with the pulmonology office. This partnership allows for a seamless transfer of patient information and fast-tracks the follow-up process. It's all about providing the best possible care to patients while reducing wait times and uncertainty, while increasing the chances of early detection and timely intervention, ultimately improving patient outcomes.
