Brad Belk, Historian Thirteen Days in Joplin, MO

For twelve days in April 1933, Clyde, Buck and Blanche Barrow, Bonnie Parker and W. D. Jones quietly hid out in a twostory garage apartment at 34th & Oak Ridge. On April 13th their tranquil hideout became the scene of a deadly shootout. The Barrow gang swiftly escaped. In their haste the criminals left substantial evidence that assisted police authorities. Bonnie and Clyde's short stay in Joplin was profoundly consequential. This became the tipping point after they savagely murdered two Joplin police officers, from that moment on there was no turning back for the infamous duo. Bonnie Parker and Clyde Barrow would be on the run till they were ambushed and killed in Louisiana (along Louisiana State Highway 154) on May 23, 1934.
