## **Eureka Springs Rotary Donates \$5,500 to ECHO**

June 29, 2010 – With proceeds raised from the 28<sup>th</sup> annual Victorian Classic Race, the Eureka Springs Rotary Club was pleased to present \$5,500 to ECHO (the Eureka Christian Health Outreach) at their Annual Installation Banquet Tuesday evening.
