GROVE ROTARY INVITES PLAYERS FOR BENEFIT GOLF TOURNAMENT SET FOR FRIDAY, MAY 6

Area golfers are invited to participate in the  $18^{th}$  annual Grove Rotary Golf Tournament on Friday, May 6, at the Patricia Island Golf Club in Grove.

Proceeds from the tournament will benefit Grove Rotary charities, including scholarships, youth programs and other community services funded by the organization.

Start time, with a shotgun scramble format, is 1 p.m. The registration fee of \$125 per player includes the greens fee for 18 holes of golf on the popular Patricia Island course, as well as cart, range balls, soft drinks, water, beer, lunch, snacks and mulligans (the golf version of a do-over). Lunch begins at 11:30 am.

The tournament will feature two flights, with the possibility of a separate flight for women if three or more female teams register. Many prizes will be given throughout the tournament. In addition, there will be a \$10,000 hole-in-one super prize.

The Grove Rotary also encourages local and area businesses and individuals to participate in tournament sponsorship opportunities. Hole sponsorships are available for \$200, or individuals can enter as a team of four golfers, plus sponsor a hole, for a total of \$650 - a savings of \$50.

The benefit golf tournament is one of several Rotary activities that raise funds for community needs, consistent with the club's motto of "Service Above Self." Rotary's primary objective is service — in the community, in the workplace, and throughout the world. Rotarians develop service projects that address critical

issues, such as children at risk, disabled persons, health care, poverty and hunger, clean water, polio eradication, literacy and numeracy.

Rotary also supports programs for youth, educational opportunities and international exchanges for students, teachers and other professionals, as well as vocational and career development.
