Neisha and her family founded the Benjamen Redix Project in his honor, and the program in making a difference in the lives of participants, both providers and recipients of the project services.

At his time of th, he was ranked #1 in the State of Arkansas in the Triple Jump. He received various awards and recognitions such as All State in football and track, was named the Kevin Bonnette player of the week, and a Track and Field award from Arkansas Preps among his other achievements. He was the recipient of the White Hall Booster Club scholarship and the Steve Strahan Memorial Scholarship. The number of wild polio cases for **2024** as of December 4, 2024 is **81**. There were 56 in Pakistan and 25 in Afghanistan.

The total number of wild polio cases for **2023** were **12**. There were 6 in Pakistan and 6 in Afghanistan.
