**INSPIRE** the love for music and fine art disciplines



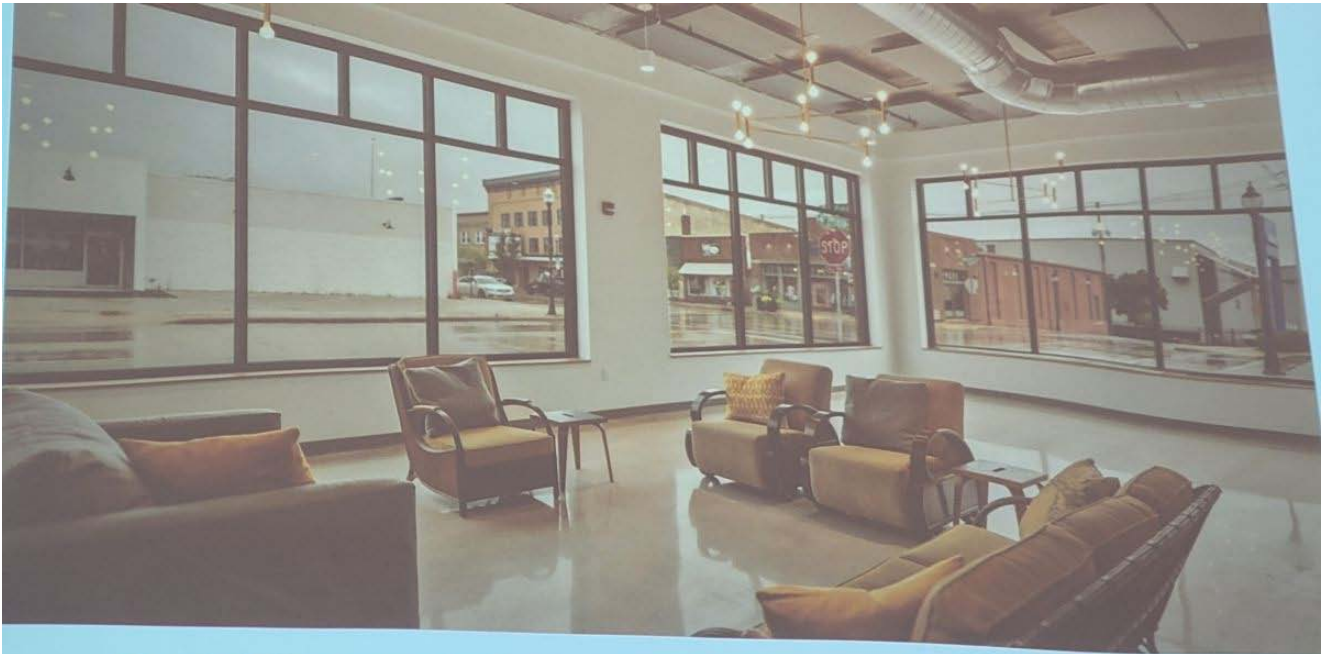
MUSE has been open since February and is still in the process of expanding their programming. A wide variety of music and program options are available, and the facility is beginning to rapidly expand its availability to the community.
