
Tonight at 7pm on PBS, the John McGivern show will be showcasing Sturgeon Bay.

Environmental Committee Chair John Swanson provided an overview of projects planned. Committee members are-Thad Birmingham, Cogging Heeringa and Keith Mutchler.

- Annual Highway cleanup-Saturday May 3rd
- Working with Sturgeon Bay on a potential project to upgrade the NE corner of the Little Lake property.

  Potential projects with "Wildones"-an environmental group interested in returning to native plants at Franky Park and Wildwood Wildlife Preserve across from Sawyer School.
- Crossroads has Knowles-Nelson Grant to purchase 17 acres across from Crossroads. Additional funding is needed to support permitting etc. The Environmental Committee presented a \$1000 check to support the project.
