- 5. Keep members engaged in Rotary. Keep telling or sharing the story of Rotary.
- 6. Lower barriers to joining. Restructuring dues might be an example.
- 7. Stay of the ahead of the game and stay informed about what Rotary does.
- 8. Focus on retention. Why are members leaving?
