### Today's Program: Tim Paap, Paap Autobody

Steve Kite introduced Tim Paap who provided an engaging presentation about the costs and benefits of Advanced Driver Assistance Systems (ADAS) which are "revolutionizing driver and vehicle safety for all". Tim's descriptions of the many sensors, cameras, mirrors, warning lights and sounds, automatic braking, lane departure and other driver corrections was so interesting! Tim discussed the impact of the ADAS on car insurance, car repair, and cost of ownership. He noted that since 2001, insurance claims are down 46%; however, the average cost of car repair has increased from \$3,800 to \$10,500. Most any repair involves ADAS. Automakers have announced that coming soon, autos will all be built with technology-ready options and owners will pay monthly subscriptions to activate each of their desired services .... subscription fees for heated seats, adaptive cruise control, lock-out service...... oh my!
