private donations and corporate donations. Only 11% of funding comes from federal support through the Corporation for Public Broadcasting. The companies with the largest investment in media are Apple, Invidia, Google, Meta, Amazon, and Facebook. There has been a marked decline in the trust that Americans have in mass media over the last few decades. Currently, only 1/3 of survey respondents have a high level of trust in media, regardless of political affiliation. The greatest level of trust is in local television and radio stations and local newspapers. WFYI's mission is "to offer lifelong learning, inspiring stories, and trusted journalism to Hoosiers of all ages and backgrounds." WFYI's journalism is committed to being "fact-based, independent, and timely." Because funding for public television comes from diverse sources, they are not beholden to any specific interest group or point of view.
