PROGRAM:

Wes Tillett came to Lafayette Urban Ministry (LUM) in



2020. Today he spoke to us about the many ways that LUM seeks to meet needs in our community. Their mission is to restore human dignity to our neighbors by giving a practical hand up. LUM is a Christian ministry, but they serve people of all faiths. Fifty-two local churches provide funding,

although that makes up only 15% of the operating budget. Support from the federal government represents 3%. The bulk of their funding comes from private donations. The projected budget for 2025 is \$1.7 million. LUM provides an overnight shelter every night of the year for those who are homeless. They also have a protein food pantry, an immigration clinic, and a tax preparation service. The immigration clinic provides legal counsel to those needing help with visas and other legal documents. The summer camp program, which we support, provides an overnight experience for eighty-four children at Hanging Rock Camp. The cost to parents is \$5, whereas the actual cost per camper is \$400.
