Meet your new Club President Brian Culp



Brian Culp began his second tour of duty as President of the Rotary Club of Plainfield on July 1, 2024. He will lead our club through June 30, 2025. Brian also served as Club President in the 2021-2022 club year.

He has been a Commercial Lines Insurance Agent for the Morgan Insurance Group since August 2016. In this capacity, Brian works with the business community's insurance needs in Hendricks, Johnson and Morgan counties, and beyond. He holds both the Certified Insurance Counselor (CIC) and Accredited Advisor in Insurance (AAI) designations.

Prior to entering the insurance business, Brian was a journalist, having spent more than 10 years with the Martinsville Reporter-Times, ending his tenure there as the paper's Managing Editor. He received his

Bachelor of Arts degree in Journalism from Franklin College, and his Master of Business Administration from Indiana Wesleyan University.

Brian grew up in Indiana, having graduated from Frankton Junior-Senior High School, north of Anderson. He now lives in Mooresville, and is married with two daughters, one in college and one in high school.

Brian joined the Rotary Club of Plainfield in July 2017, but originally became a Rotarian in 2006 at the old Mooresville Rotary Club.
